

## Ingredients

1 White cotton dish towel (laundered)  
8" x 8" piece of freezer paper  
Crayons & Floss:  
Olive  
Orange  
Black  
Brown  
Hot dry iron  
Brown Micron 01 pen  
- OR -  
Sharp pencil  
4 scraps of muslin (8" x 8")

## Instructions

1) Iron shiny side down the freezer paper to the back of your towel in your desired location of Jack.

2) Trace Jack using a lightbox or window to your towel with a light touch using your Micron pen or pencil.

3) Color in just as you would when you were a kid (sans eyes & teeth). Press hard or light to get desired shading effects. The freezer paper will help stabilize your towel from stretching as you color Crayon Jack.

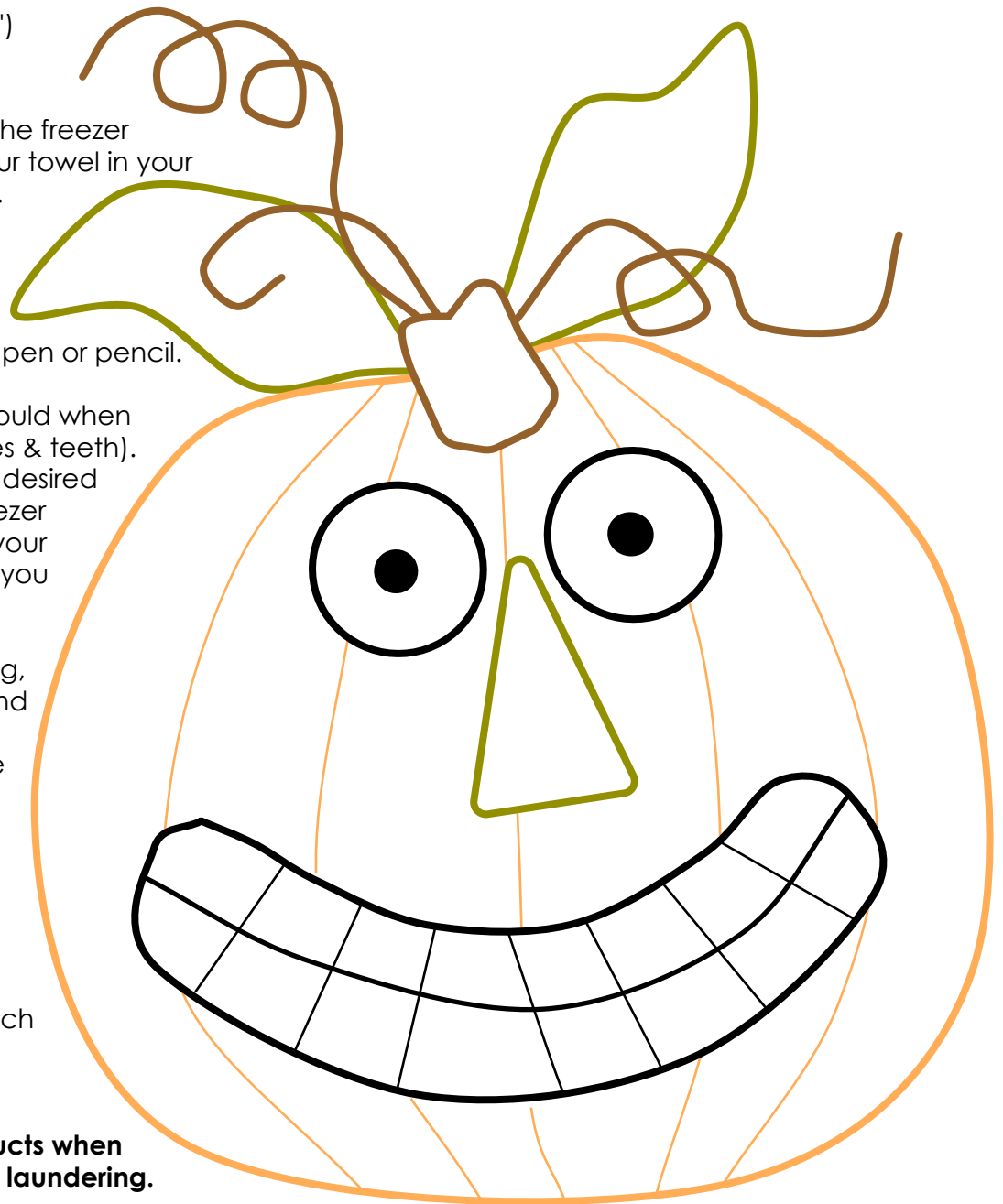
4) When finished coloring, remove freezer paper and place a muslin scrap on the backside and on the front of your crayon masterpiece. Press with a HOT iron (the cotton setting) to set the color. The scraps will absorb some of the color. You may want to repeat this process to absorb as much of the wax as possible.

5) Embroider. Done! :-)

**NOTE: Avoid "Oxy" products when laundering.**
